- Advise colleagues and customers on technical issues and possible solutions.
- Support less experienced colleagues and share new techniques and insights.
- Work independently and safely in a clean and well-organised workshop.

- You hold a bachelor's degree in a technical field (automotive mechanics, electromechanics, automotive technology, electronics, etc.) or have equivalent experience.
- You can confidently read and use electrical schematics, technical drawings and diagnostic systems.
- You have in-depth knowledge of electrical systems and/or internal combustion engines.
- You also have a solid foundation in hydraulics and a good understanding of internal combustion engines.
- You are comfortable working with both manual measuring tools and advanced diagnostic equipment.
- You can analyse technical documentation, combine machine measurements and observations with information from diagnostic tools, and use this information to establish accurate diagnoses.
- You have at least 5 years of experience in a similar technical role.
- You enjoy working independently while also supporting and guiding colleagues.

- You are fluent in Dutch or French, and knowledge of English is an additional asset for analysing technical documentation related to our machines.
